

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

ABOUT CROMWELL

Rugged mountains, the meeting of two rivers, the pristine waters of Lake Dunstan, and seemingly endless orchards and vineyards – it's easy to see why Cromwell has such a special place in so many people's hearts, and why it continues to enthrall visitors who take the time to discover this hidden gem.

The area was first populated in 1862 during the Otago gold rush when two miners, Horatio Hartley and Christopher Reilly, discovered gold just below the junction of the Clutha and Kawarau Rivers. The rush that followed brought miners in their thousands to Central Otago.

Most of the town that sprung up, then called The Junction, was flooded in the early 1990s when the Clyde Dam was built. Several of the historic buildings were demolished and rebuilt on higher ground, and stand to this day as a testimony to the grit and unbreakable spirit of the first people who called this land home.

Cromwell has long since shaken off its service town image. Now it is a destination in its own right with a thriving and vibrant community that cultivates export quality produce and some of the best wines in the world.



What's in a Name?

Before the gold rush of 1862, the region where Cromwell now stands was known as Tirau, named for the many cabbage trees that provided food to the Maori tribes travelling through the region. When the miners arrived, the area was named The Junction after the confluence of the Kawarau and Clutha rivers.

Legend has it that Cromwell got its name when surveyors arrived to map the town. A group of Irish prospectors saw their presence as a threat to their claims. Suspicion turned to anger, which then quickly turned to violence. A fight erupted and only stopped when the head surveyor called:

"Stop! Get back to your diggings or I'll put the Curse of Cromwell on you!"

(referring, of course, to the infamous Oliver Cromwell for whom our town is named).

And the rest, as they say, is history.



What's up with Neplusultra?

Neplusultra is arguably the most exotic and most ironic street name in New Zealand. As this street was once where the town ended and the wilderness began, the name used to be quite apt.

The phrase "ne plus ultra" means "no more beyond" in Latin, and was famously said to have been inscribed on the Pillars of Hercules at the Strait of Gibraltar to warn sailors not to travel beyond the end of the known world.

Cromwell has since grown well beyond this early border with a golf course, houses, restaurants and more bringing order to where there once was only wilderness.



5. ENJOY OUR GREAT OUTDOORS




Fireworks

Cromwell Half Marathon

This family-friendly, fun event takes you around the shores of beautiful Lake Dunstan, passing through the Heritage Precinct, with a backdrop of spectacular mountain views. You can walk or run the 10-km track as an individual or as part of a team.

Nevis Valley Gutbuster

Cromwell Spring Market



What to expect WEATHER-WISE

- On average, Cromwell's warmest month is January, and its coldest July.
- Our driest month is August with only an average of 20mm of rain, and January is the wettest with an average of 48mm. In general, our region's rainfall is far lower than the national average of 600 to 1600 mm per annum.
- Less rain means more sunshine! Cromwell boasts around 2100 hours of sunshine every year.

AVERAGE MONTHLY SUNSHINE HOURS - CROMWELL




If you're bored while in Cromwell, it's your own fault. Here are heaps of great activities to get stuck into – from family fun with the kids to heart-pumping adventures for the adrenaline junkies!

No matter what your budget, mood, or interest, there is something to keep everyone happy and busy.

Free activities in Cromwell:

- **HIT THE TRAIL**
Take a bicycle or your running shoes and explore our various trails, tracks, and green spaces. The latest addition, the Lake Dunstan Cycle and Walking Trail, runs along the shores of Lake Dunstan all the way from Smiths Way to the north of Pisa Moorings to Clyde.
- **GO BACK IN TIME**
Take a stroll through the historic buildings in the Heritage Precinct, visit the Cromwell Museum or discover more on the Otago Goldfields Heritage Trail.
- **BIKE PARK**
Test your skills on two wheels. The bike park in Achil street has five circuits varying in difficulty, from a paved learn-to-ride area to a jump loop for more experienced cyclists.
- **TAKE IT EASY**
Have a picnic next to Lake Dunstan and, if you're brave enough, have a swim in the crystal clear water.
- **BROWSE THE FARMERS MARKET**
Held every Sunday between Labour Day and Easter, the Farmer's Market in the Heritage Precinct offers local produce, art, food, wine, and entertainment.
- **UNLEASH YOUR INNER PHOTOGRAPHER**
No matter the season, the stark contrasts of the Cromwell Basin present many photo opportunities for professional and budding photographers alike.
- **BONUS: TAKE A SELFIE**
Take a selfie in front of the Big Fruit. Go on, we know you want to!
- **SKATE PARK**
Roll on over to the Big Fruit and grind a few ledges or practice your kickflips.



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- **BIKE HIRE** from our Clyde Shop and from Forge Cafe in Cromwell. Trek Roscoe's 6's and Merida E Bikes perfect!

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Goldfields Mining Centre is situated 8 kms from Cromwell under the towering peaks of Mt Difficulty and beside the mighty Kawarau River, in the Kawarau Gorge, State Highway 6.

This historic site was mined for over 100 years, and during the 1860s was known as 'Gees Flat'. Hundreds of men came from all over the world, not least the Chinese, to seek their fortunes.

Join one of our local guides on a 1 hour tour whilst they weave the stories of our gold rush, inform and entertain. Be amazed as they operate the old stamper battery and sluice gun, and enjoy their expert tuition at our panning area to conclude the tour.

If gold fever sets in (as it frequently does!) enjoy a further half hour to carry on panning.

We will provide you with a map whereby you have the opportunity to walk in the footsteps of hardy miners, through trails, tailings, and the Chinese Village. (Imagine how conditions would have been for those intrepid souls!)

The Goldfields Experience takes 1.5 to 2 hours. Tours run hourly throughout the day.

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The course has 5 tee locations ranging from beginner to championship providing a real challenge for all levels of golfer.



There is a reason we have that "cheeky" Big Fruit sculpture at the entrance to our town. Cromwell's arid climate makes the basin a unique region for cherry and apricot growing.

Know your cherries

Variety	Available	Description
Stella	Late Dec to early-Jan	Dark red, sweet, attractive heart shaped
Romance	Early Jan	Dark red, large, sweet and firm
Kordia	Mid-Jan	Dark fleshed cherry, firm and delicious
Lapins	Early to mid-Jan	Large mahogany red cherry with excellent firmness and flavour
Skeena	Mid Jan	Large, very firm and sweet, dark red to almost black
Sweetheart	Mid to late Jan	Large crunchy, heart-shaped, bright red with a mild sweet flesh and outstanding firmness
Staccato	Late Jan to early Feb	Large, very crunchy red black cherry with super sweet burgundy flesh

Our cold winters provide ample chilling to ensure healthy trees and the low summer rainfall and regular sunshine provides the perfect location to produce export summer fruit.

Often called the fruit bowl of the South, Cromwell town is surrounded by hundreds of hectares of apricot, peach, nectarine, and pip fruit orchards. This is besides the rows and rows of cherry trees that produce enough export quality fruit to keep visitors and locals sweet throughout the summer season. Many orchards offer tours and pick-your-own options if you'd like to get amongst it.

Cromwell, formerly known as
The Junction, started out as a
mining settlement when gold was
discovered here in 1862.

A flood of people descended on the area in search of their fortune, and by 1871 the permanent population of Cromwell stood at 497. The town then boasted three banks, a post office, and a number of other stone buildings. Although the miners and the gold have now gone, traces of the town's early days are still visible. You can also follow the Otago Goldfields Heritage Trail to discover more of the region's notable sites and relics.

A second, more literal flood, helped shape Cromwell into the town it is today. In 1993, parts of the town and valley were flooded with the construction of the Clyde Dam. Several of the historic buildings were removed and rebuilt in the Heritage Precinct. These buildings, including Captain Barry's cottage, the London House Stables, and the Belfast Store, are lovingly maintained. Some are even still in use as cafés, restaurants, shops, and offices!

If you would like to find out more about our fascinating history, a visit to the Cromwell Museum, located in the centre of the Cromwell Mall is a must. The museum is home to some amazing artefacts from our early days.

For true wine connoisseurs and casual wine-lovers alike, Cromwell offers a multitude of beautiful boutique wines to sample and enjoy.



The Cromwell Basin has only 5% of New Zealand's vineyard area, but is home to 20% of the country's wineries. With over thirty cellar doors and wineries in the region, you can easily spend the best part of a week sampling the vintages and varietals.

Thanks to our icy winters and long, hot summers, the Cromwell basin is home to some of the best Pinot Noir wines in the world. Although Pinot Noir clearly dominates, the region also produces world-class Pinot Gris, Chardonnay, Riesling, and Sauvignon Blanc wines.

The first wine-grapes were planted in Central Otago in 1864, but it took nearly a century for wine-grapes to be grown commercially. The region comprises four distinct sub-regions that are separated by rugged river valleys and mountains. The Cromwell Basin, which includes Bannockburn in the south and stretches to Bendigo in the North, contains the largest concentration of the region's vineyards.

There are plenty of options for beer connoisseurs in the area too. From light pale ales to heavier hops, stouts, and even flavoured beers, Cromwell's burgeoning craft beer scene has more than enough to fill your flagon.
